THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

- If you decide to work with a food truck, try talking to them first, before booking. Oftentimes they will give discounts if there is a certain amount being purchased, or you can work out special pricing. Oth ers have a minimum sales amount they require, so it's good to call around to the ones you're interest ed in and make sure it's a good fit.
- Food trucks are popular, especially around holidays! Start booking early to make sure you get the one(s) you want.
- Check with your HOA about the specific rules in your neighborhood before booking a food truck/ bounce house.
- For bounce houses and inflatables, make sure to ask about liability, as well as how they plan to stake down the inflatables.
- Make sure to have a back-up plan in case of weather or other events.
